

POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Pool Access: Valid photo ID must be shown to the attendant on duty for admission to the pool for both residents and guests.

Children: Any child under 14 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times when in the pool enclosure and must be supervised properly as is required by general rules and regulations of the apartment community. **THE LIFEGUARD IS NOT A BABYSITTER!!!**

Guests: Residents are permitted to have 1 guest; however, the hosting resident MUST be with the guest at all times.

Showering: Health Department regulations require all swimmers to shower before entering the pool. This means each time you go in, not just one time per visit to the pool. To keep our filtration system in good condition, please be especially careful to wash off all suntan products and other oils.

Use of pool: The pool will be open as designated and posted or announced. A lifeguard will be on duty during these hours and will keep the pool area clean and enforce the rules and regulations.

Use of the facilities at own risk: Residents and any other persons using the pool, pool area, locker rooms and other recreational facilities and equipment do so at their own risk. Landlord and managing agent are not liable or in any way responsible for any personal injuries or property losses of residents, guests or invitees or any person who may use the facilities.

Chairs and pool furniture: Chairs and lounge furniture may not be reserved for anyone who is not in the pool or pool enclosure.

Long hair and cut-offs: Long hair must be pinned or tied while swimming; no cut-off jeans or other garments are allowed in the pool. Long hairs and frayed threads cause damage to the pool filtration system.

Radios at the pool: Volume should be limited so as not to disturb others.

Running: No running, playing ball, fighting, pushing or other rough play permitted in the pool or pool enclosure

Beverages: Glass containers, breakable objects and gum are not permitted in the pool area. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the pool area.

Smoking: Smoking is not permitted in the pool or near the pool edge. Smoking permitted in designated area ONLY.

Litter: Litter must be placed in the appropriate receptacles provided by the management.

Objects in the pool: Tubes, rafts, floating chairs and beach balls are permitted when there are fewer than ten (10) people in the pool.

Hygiene: Spitting of water and other unhygienic actions are strictly prohibited.

Closing: Anyone entering the pool enclosure without permission or after closing hours will lose all pool privileges for the remainder of the pool season.

Lifeguard: The lifeguards may make decisions or determinations deemed necessary. Please give them your full cooperation.

Refusal: Management reserves the right to refuse pool privileges to anyone violating the above rules.
